Re-emergence of WPV1 in North-East Nigeria. Caused by insurgency and interruption in AFP surveillance

Monkeypox reported after 40 years

2019

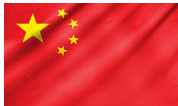
Lassa fever outbreaks
