









Cheng-Dzau NAM-CUHK International Health Policy Fellowship Program 2025-26





Programme Overview

The Cheng-Dzau CUHK-NAM International Health Policy Fellowship Program provides early-to-mid-career faculty at CUHK with a unique opportunity to collaborate with health leaders at the US National Academy of Medicine. Fellows will contribute to important health policy research, develop international leadership skills, and gain invaluable experience in policy analysis and implementation. The fellowship includes a two-year term with a 25%-time residency in Washington, D.C., and culminates in the completion and presentation of an impactful policy project.

Eligibility Criteria

Applicants must meet the following requirements:

- Be a full-time CUHK faculty member in early to mid-career (approximately 2–10 years postgraduate work experience)
- Doctoral degree preferred (MD, PhD, DSc, DO, DrPH, JD, MBChB, MBBS, or equivalent); other graduate degrees may be considered
- · Be proficient in speaking, reading, and writing English
- · Demonstrated commitment to improving health, healthcare, and health policy

Programme Structure

- Highly prestigious two-year fellowship (one fellow selected biennially)
- · 25%-time residency in Washington, D.C., including an initial intensive three-month period
- · Fellow will maintain current CUHK appointment and salary during the fellowship
- Development and completion of an individualized project, culminating in a final report and a presentation to NAM and CUHK leadership
